Around the world, Christians face abuse, threats, violence, arrest, prison and even death because of their choice to follow Jesus. And many still choose to follow, knowing the risk. This is **brave faith** being lived out - the perspective that knowing Jesus is truly worth everything we have.

Safety. Money. Freedom. Reputation. Career. Friends. Even family. All this can be at stake, but brave faith chooses to keep focused on Jesus, knowing He is worth more than everything else.

In this guide, you'll meet six Christians from around the world who are bravely living out their faith in Jesus. They have chosen Him to be front and centre, and in doing that have seen their lives changed and transformed.

We want to take you on a journey of brave faith with them. Their stories are challenging and inspiring. They can encourage us to have greater passion and perseverance – showing us that taking risks and getting out of our comfort zones can deepen our relationship with God.

Want to grow in passion and courage for Jesus? That's what this brave faith guide and the next six weeks is all about. Up for it? Turn over to find out what this journey will look like.



HOW DOES THIS WORK?



For Kabil*, who's from a country in North Africa, choosing Jesus has been the toughest, yet best, choice he's ever made.

"BIG PROBLEMS STARTED, AND I HAD TO CHOOSE BETWEEN MY FAMILY AND JESUS... I DECIDED TO FOLLOW THE LORD. I GAVE UP MY FAMILY, MY HOME AND MY BUSINESS." Kabil, North Africa

In his country, most people are Muslims and leaving Islam for another religion can create big problems. Initially, Kabil's parents were OK with his choice. But then things changed. His family made him choose between them and Jesus. Kabil made his choice, and since then his family have disowned him.

This was incredibly hard for Kabil, but he knows he has made the right choice

"NOTHING CAN EQUAL THE LIFE THAT JESUS GAVE TO ME".

Open Doors

Choosing to follow Jesus has a cost but, as Kabil shows, that cost is worth it. Jesus asks us to put Him first, to make brave choices about how we live our lives and show His love to the world around us. Like Kabil, we need to make regular, brave choices to keep following Jesus wherever He leads.

BIBLE PASSAGE: Read this passage: Mark 10:29-30

- What do you find hard about what Jesus says? Jesus might not be asking you to give up family or home, but is there something in your life that you put above God? What is it? Reputation, security, looks, fashion, gaming?
- Ask God to help you put Him first and choose to use the thing(s) you've pinpointed for Him.





For many, simply asking Jesus to come into their lives is the bravest, most dangerous prayer they will ever pray. But many pray it anyway, knowing the consequences. One guy from North Africa told his story to an Open Doors partner. Before he became a Christian, this man was a wealthy Muslim. But he was having serious questions about God. So, one day he prayed a brave prayer:

"GOD IF YOU'RE REAL YOU NEED TO COME AND SEE ME."

That afternoon, he came home from work and found a man standing in his house. When he asked the stranger who he was, the man said, "Jesus." They then spoke for an hour (yep, we know, it's wild. But read on, it gets better).

When his wife came home, he told her he was now a Christian. She was furious, knowing the decision could lose them everything. The man said to his wife, "Well, you ask Jesus to come, and He will come." The next day, the man found a letter nailed to the tree in their front garden. It was from his wife. She'd written her own brave prayer: "Dear Jesus, my husband says You are real and You will come, so please come."

A few days later, the man came home and found his wife sobbing on the floor. When he asked her what was wrong she said, "Jesus came and visited me, we spoke for an hour. We are now Christian."

Today, that couple lead a house church. Because of their decision to follow Jesus they have lost their status, reputation, safety and wealth. But they know those prayers were worth it. They've experienced God's world-changing love and He's using them to share that freedom-giving love with others! Ready to pray that same life-changing prayer?



THE BIBLE TEACHES US IN 2 CORINTHIANS 3:18 THAT AS WE LOOK TO GOD, WE ARE BEING CHANGED TO BE MORE LIKE HIM. SO, BE HONEST, WHAT DO YOU FEEL GOD MAY WANT TO CHANGE IN YOU? IT COULD BE SOMETHING BIG OR SOMETHING SMALL.

God loves us completely, and His heart for us is that we would listen to what He says about us more than those around us. We might worry we're not attractive enough, cool enough or generally good enough. We might have a bunch of habits that we know we need to deal with or that our friends might easily lead us into. But no matter what you've written down, God is big enough to deal with it. There's no judgment; God's heard everything before and He's big enough to help you get through it. Don't believe us? You don't have to – just read Pablo's incredible story.

Pablo* is from Colombia. When he was a teenager, he smuggled drugs for a rebel gang. He would drive around in a truck dropping off cocaine to various dealers and passing out anti-government leaflets. One day, enemies of the gang he was working for caught him. To save his life he told them everything he knew about his gang. He escaped, but he was on the run.

He didn't have anywhere to go and his old gangmates would be after him if they discovered what he did. This is where God stepped in. Pablo met some Christians; they told him about Jesus and he realized God had spared his life for a reason.

After meeting an Open Doors volunteer, Pablo made a brave change. He decided to go back to smuggling, but this time he'd be taking Bibles, rather than drugs, into dangerous parts of Colombia.

It's not an easy job. The rebel soldiers he used to work for are violently committed to their beliefs, and the gospels that Pablo delivers offer a very different way of thinking. There is a price on his head. He's had to go into hiding a few times – they see him as a target for trying to show people a way of living free from drugs. But he keeps going, and that brave change is helping others to make brave changes too.

BIBLE PASSAGE: Read: Luke 19:1-10

- How did people react when Jesus asked to go to Zacchaeus' house? Why did they think he wasn't good enough for Jesus?
- Jesus knew Zacchaeus made a lot of money exploiting his own people. But Jesus still asked to spend time with him. Jesus invites us to come to Him now - it doesn't matter if you're not perfect, it doesn't matter what you've done and it doesn't even matter if you're not a Christian, He still invites us to come to Him.
- We don't know how long Jesus and Zacchaeus spent together, but it wasn't long. In that short time with Jesus, Zacchaeus completely changed. If we want to change, spending time with Jesus should be where we start.







1. Change it up. Like Pablo, Open Doors is passionate about making sure people have access to God's Word. Just \$10 can buy, send and deliver a Bible to a young Christian facing persecution. Could you change something in your life for two weeks to save up \$10 and help send a Bible? Make a change and stop buying drinks, snacks or that new game and instead get God's Word into the hands of someone who would totally treasure it! More at <u>opendoorscanada.org/bravefaith</u>.

2. Choose to change. Look at the answer you wrote down at the start of this reflection. Can you make that change alone? Do you need help from someone you trust? Do you need to take some concrete action to help you change? A simple meeting with Jesus transformed Zacchaeus' life, but Zacchaeus still had to act. Jesus didn't force him or tell him to do anything, Zacchaeus made a change as a reaction to knowing God's acceptance and love. Can you make a brave choice to reach out to someone you know and trust now to help you make a change?

PRAYER:

God, thank You for believers like Pablo and others like him who have had their world turned upside down. Thank You for his brave faith and I pray that You will keep believers strong in their faith as they follow where You lead. Thank You for the story of when Zacchaeus met You and how that transformed him. Help me open up to You today. Help me to spot things You want to do in me. 

GOD CAN HELP US TO CHANGE!







EVER DONE A BUNGEE OR PARACHUTE JUMP? EVER STOOD UP FOR SOMEONE WHO WAS BEING BULLIED? EVER BROKEN UP A FIGHT?



What's the bravest thing you've ever done?

Often we think that being brave is about physical strength. But, if we follow Jesus' example, we know that true bravery is about love. When we love God and love others, then brave actions follow.

This is something Pastor Shiyanth* from Sri Lanka knows well. For the last few years his church has faced strong opposition from its local community. Most people in the area are devout Hindus and don't want a church in their area. Some more extreme Hindus had repeatedly tried to shut down the church and when their initial efforts failed, they just got more angry. A member of the church was violently attacked as he walked home, and when four other Christians tried to stop them, they were also beaten, had rocks thrown at them and were pelted with garbage.

Understandably, the church was in shock, and more bad news was to come. Not long after. Covid-19 hit. and the country was put under lockdown. Without work, people had no means of providing for their families. Pastor Shiyanth, seeing this great need, stepped in, and with help from Open Doors his church was able to provide supplies for the entire village.

Over 100 families received help – even those who had tried to close the church and had carried out the attack. They said: "The church could have just helped their own believers. They didn't have to help us, but they did. Why did we do so much against them?"

This was love. This was brave. The church could have kept quiet and tried to avoid any further violence from the community. But instead they acted, bravely serving those that hated them. As a result, the church has been able to share God's love with more and more people!

BIBLE: Read this passage: Matthew 5:38-42

• What do you think of this passage? Is Jesus just telling people to be nice in the face of injustice?

Jesus is encouraging His followers to realize that, in the midst of conflict and threats, they have a choice. They can escalate the situation, or they can choose another way. Some theologians point to old first-century customs to argue that Jesus' ideal responses (turning the other cheek etc.) are about shaming those who start conflict - with a dignified defiance, they turn the situation entirely on its head.

- How do these examples relate to Pastor Shiyanth's church? How are they living out this message?
- Can you think of times in your life where someone has wronged you? How did you respond? How would you like to have responded? Reading Jesus' words, would you respond differently now?
- How is living out the words of Jesus in this passage an example of brave faith?





1. Choose to encourage brave faith in others. Open Doors regularly organizes letterwriting campaigns for persecuted Christians to let them know they are not alone. Visit opendoorscanada.org/write to find out who you could write to this week. Read the stories, pray for the people involved and write a message that will raise brave faith in your persecuted family.

2. Go the extra mile. If someone asks you to do something like tidy your room, clear up a classroom or help out with cleaning up, do it. Challenge yourself to not complain, but take what is asked of you and do it. Then, take it further – go beyond the minimum expected of you – go the extra mile! Don't just stack the dishwasher, empty it too; don't just tidy your room, give it a vacuum as well. As you choose to do these (maybe) slightly annoying tasks, your different attitude could well get some great reactions from others!

PRAYER:

Father God, thank You that You love me even when I do wrong. Thank You that You show us we can forgive and not have to enter into a cycle of anger or violence. Be with Pastor Shiyanth and his church in Sri Lanka. Thank You for their example, and help me follow Jesus just like they are, living out their faith in ways that bring change and restoration. I pray for that community in Sri Lanka and that the church would continue to show Your love so many more come to know You. Amen.



"MY PASTOR TAUGHT ME THAT WHENEVER I SEE SOMEONE WHO IS SICK, I SHOULD PRAY FOR THEM IN FAITH AND THEY WILL BE HEALED. SO I PRAYED FOR MANY SICK PEOPLE. THEY EXPERIENCED HEALING. SEEING SO MANY MIRACLES, MORE PEOPLE STARTED COMING TO ME, WANTING ME TO PRAY FOR THEM." Subhash, India

Subhash* knows all about living bravely for Jesus. He became a Christian when his wife was healed through a prayer. Because he'd seen prayer answered, he began praying for lots of other people. Before long, he was holding packed out prayer meetings.

But all this attention angered some local people who believed that all Indians should be Hindus, not Christians. False charges were brought against Subhash. He was arrested and put in prison. Locked in his cell, he was pretty angry, but he remembered stories of others who had been imprisoned for their faith. He followed their example and started to pray. He didn't just pray for a few minutes, he prayed for five days and nights non-stop. After that, things changed:

"GOD USED ME INSIDE THE PRISON. I SHARED THE GOSPEL WITH TWELVE OTHER INMATES. ELEVEN OF THEM BELIEVED, SO I TAUGHT THEM HOW TO PRAY".

As Subhash shows, living bravely starts small. Subhash was inspired to pray, so he kept praying. Each small prayer was a risk - praying for those from other faiths, praying for the sick, praying for the rich and powerful. And that's what living bravely is; staying the course, gradually taking bigger risks for Jesus. Subhash kept going, kept taking risks and in the end, even prison couldn't stop him!

BIBLE PASSAGE: Read this passage: Luke 5:1-11

- When the first disciples chose to follow Jesus, they made one simple decision. They had no idea where it would lead, but like Subhash, they chose to embrace that first risky step.
- Why did Simon leave his life as a fisherman? What do you think he saw in Jesus?



- Simon was scared. He knew Jesus was responsible for this massive catch of fish. He knew this man was holy, different and even special. And he knew this interaction would change his life. He was right to be a little scared. Be honest, do you worry about where following Jesus could lead?
- Jesus sees this worry in Simon. He says 'don't be afraid' and gives him a new direction - a new journey with Jesus at the lead. Jesus says the same to us - "Don't worry; follow Me." While Simon's life changed, 2,000 years on, we still know about him – not bad for an uneducated fisherman!

1. Choose to lose: Take part in the 'Choose to Lose Challenge' and get sponsored to make a change and give up something you love for a short time to raise money and prayer for people like Subhash who have given everything for Jesus. Remember Jesus' words to Simon, "Don't worry; follow Me". Offer to pray for them over text – if they say yes, send a text with your prayer on it! Whatever they say, keep praying for them, and ask them if there's stuff they'd like you to keep praying for.

PRAYER:

Father God, thank You for Subhash and many others like him who are willing to be used by You no matter what the cost. Let there be many more like Subhash bringing Your love and hope to those they meet. Help me have the same attitude as Subhash. Give me courage to pray for others, help me be sensitive to what You are saying and how people are feeling. Holy Spirit, help me live brave! Amen.

Did you list anything about risk, rejection and exclusion? What about friends turning their backs on you or losing your money, career and reputation? These don't sound like things anyone would really choose, but when Berhane in Ethiopia became a Christian, she knew her future would instantly change. She didn't plan on becoming a Christian; her family followed a traditional religion and she even used to pick on the Christian girls at school.

But that changed when Berhane heard her Christian neighbours singing. The noise would annoy her, but the words from the songs stuck in her head. She even found herself singing them. Finally, she went to a Christian girl at school – a girl she had always teased – and told her that she wanted to follow Jesus.

That's when her future went in a totally different direction. Her parents quickly found out and they made her leave the house. Her family wouldn't go near her, they thought she was 'unclean'.

"ON THE ODD OCCASION THAT I MADE IT INTO MY PARENTS' COMPOUND, THEY WOULD SHOUT FOR ME TO LEAVE. I WAS CRYING BECAUSE I MISSED THEM... THEY KEPT THEMSELVES FAR FROM ME."

But despite facing a future as an outcast, Berhane embraced what was ahead. It must have been hard, but that journey has made her who she is today; an evangelist who shares about Jesus in some incredibly risky places. Berhane has helped plant nine churches, and one of them is thriving in an extremely hostile area! And that's not all. Inspired by seeing how God was protecting her daughter, Berhane's mother also became a Christian. Amazingly, around 100 members of Berhane's extended family have now chosen to follow Jesus too. Where the future looked bleak, Berhane chose to see a brave new path, one where God is walking with and leading her. So, what does your future hold? Choose to follow, keep saying 'Yes' to God like Brother Andrew, and you'll never know where you'll end up!

BIBLE:

Read: Mark 14:17-26

Jesus knew His future was dark, but He chose it anyway. Scan through the rest of Mark and you'll see that He's betrayed, denied by His closest friend, subjected to all kinds of lies and taunts, and tortured, humiliated and publicly executed. Like many of us, when faced with a harsh, horrible future, He asks why God isn't there (Mark 15:34).

- How do you respond when bad things start unfolding in your life?
- What did Jesus do? Did He try and change the plan, or trust in God's direction?
- Jesus persevered through pain and even death. What was the outcome?
